QUALIFIED APPLICANTS MUST HAVE 3 YEARS FULL-TIME, LICENSED, ACTIVE REAL ESTATE EXPERIENCE AND 60 DOCUMENTED EXPERIENCE POINTS (COMPLYING WITH R162-2f-401a) WITHIN THE 5 YEARS PROCEEDING APPLICATION

- 1) Applicants applying for a broker license shall select from the applicant's documented experience at least 60 points but no more than 80 points for consideration and review by the Division of Real Estate. (R162-2f-202b(1)(F)(iv) and (R162-2f-501(1))
- 2) When calculating experience points from Tables 1 and 2 experience points are limited to points for those activities which require a real estate license and comply with R162(2f)(401)(a).
- 3) When calculating experience points from Table 2, the total combined monthly experience credit claimed for "all other property management combined" (both residential and commercial) **may not exceed 25 points** in any application to practice as a real estate broker. (**R162-2f-202b(1)(f)(ii)(A) and R162-2f-501 Appendix 2 (c)**)
- 4) When calculating experience points involving a team or group, experience points are limited to those transactions for which the individual is named in any written agency agreements and purchase and/or lease contracts. Experience points will be divided proportionally among the licensees identified in the agency agreements and/or purchase or lease contracts. (R162-2f-202b(1)(f)(v))
- 5) A minimum of one half of the points in Tables 1, 2 and 3 must be derived **from transactions of properties located in Utah.** (R162-2f-501(2))
